

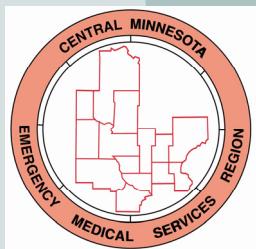

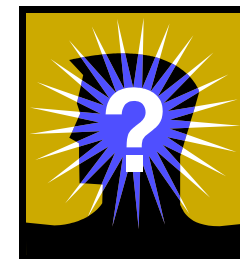


### *March 21: Suicide Information for CISM Teams*

## B. Anne Balboni

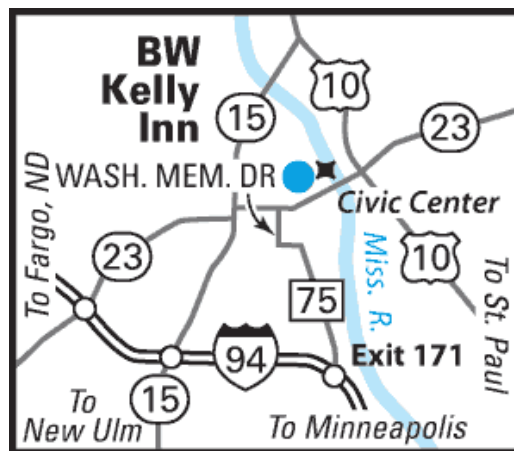
